



The Lighthouse Inc., utilizes the MPAI-4 measurement system to assess and report the functional improvements for our residents. Measurements are formatted in a standard T-Score measurement to allow comparative analysis. The T-Scores aid in the identification of a resident's level of functioning, which is measured in specific areas, such as: ability, emotional health, participation, and a total measurement. Decreased T-scores represent improved levels of functioning according to the MPAI-4 assessment reports

The Lighthouse Inc., reports functional gains on two groups of residents:

1. Residents receiving *Intensive Rehabilitative Services* (10 therapies or more, per week).
2. Residents receiving *Long Term Living Support Services* (less than 10 therapies, per week).

The Lighthouse goal for residents in the Intensive Rehabilitative Services group was to demonstrate a functional gain between time of admission and discharge. As evident in the diagram above, the Lighthouse Inc., met this goal and reported functional improvements in all reporting domains.

The Lighthouse goal for residents in the Long Term Living Support Services was successful with positive outcomes in 75% of the specified domains.
